



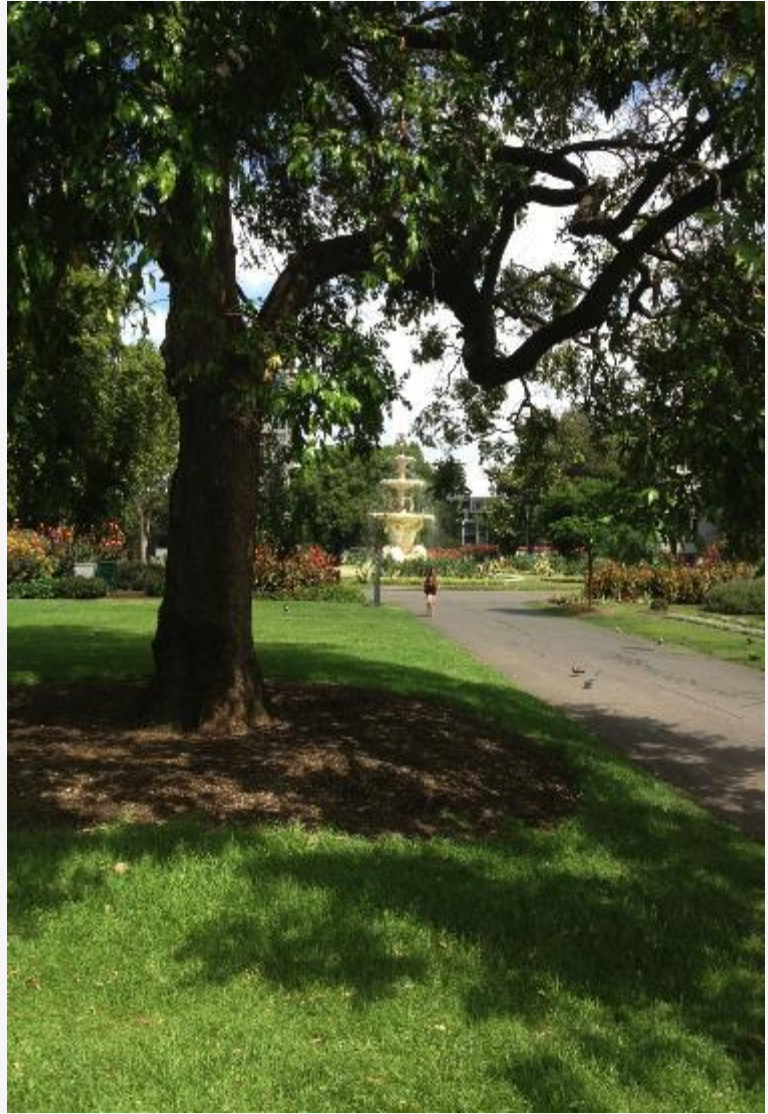
A walk to the park
