

GoodStart Training College Rules for Candidates

While attending GoodStart Training College, candidates will be required to adhere to the following rules:

- Fraudulent activity will not be accepted to any degree at any time. Any form of cheating on assessments will be treated as a serious matter and immediately referred to a Departmental officer for disciplinary action. GoodStart Training College reserves the right to suspend and refuse entry to any candidate suspected of cheating or entering into any form of fraudulent activity.
- No smoking inside any part of the training sites at any time. Whilst smoking is permitted outside the building, candidates cannot smoke within 4 metres of any doorway. Please use the bins provided to dispose of butts. Smokers will be required to pick up all and any butts not disposed of properly.
- Respect your peers, Respect your trainers, Respect our staff. GoodStart Training College understands and supports the idea that all staff are treated as part of the work team. This may include playful banter and using first names with all staff. However, GoodStart Training College does not support and will not tolerate abusive language and degrading references towards any candidate, staff member or visitor for any reason.
- Every GoodStart Training College candidate has the right to attend workshops and/or training sites. Candidates have the right to participate fully, free from bullying or other forms of abuse. Candidates who behave inappropriately including engaging in activities that could lead to injury to another person or themselves or who engage in discriminating activities including sexual harassment will be expelled immediately. This is a zero tolerance policy.
- Whilst swearing may be a normal part of some industries, it is requested that swearing be kept to a minimum.
- Food and drinks are not to be taken into classrooms. The exception is bottled water.
- Sitting on desks or benches is not permitted at any time.
- Candidates are to vacate classrooms during meal breaks, unless a trainer is present.
- Candidates are not permitted into any of the storerooms unless accompanied by a trainer.
- Fire doors are not to be propped open.
- While candidates may leave the training site at meal breaks, you are required to advise your trainer or a fellow candidate of your absence. This is to ensure your trainer is aware of your absence should an emergency evacuation occur.
- GoodStart Training College has a strict “No Alcohol, No Drugs” policy. Candidates who exhibit signs of intoxication either by alcohol or drugs will be refused entry or re-entry to the college. This is a zero tolerance policy that candidates should consider carefully before consuming alcohol or drugs during attendance at GoodStart Training College. GoodStart Training College reserves the right to cancel a candidate’s enrolment should he or she show signs of intoxication either by alcohol or drugs.

Any candidate who is found abusing college rules, the facilities and/or equipment will be escorted from the premises and their employer notified immediately.
